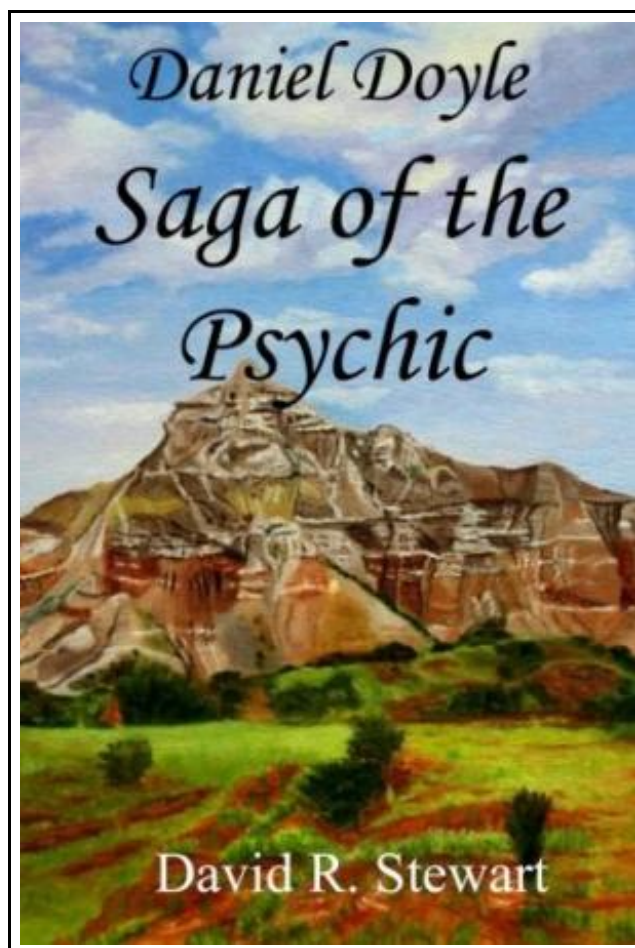


Daniel Doyle, Saga of the Psychic

Just shy of his thirteenth birthday, Daniel Doyle, a backward, diminutive, Irish lad was conscripted into the British army. Sent to America, he took part in the Battle of New Orleans as a drummer boy.
